

Pioneers for the Good of ALL in Beachwood Canyon

- Assists the organizing of Neighborhood Watch Groups
- Lead the effort to get a flight rule (2,000 feet above ground level) established for all non-emergency/non-military helicopters over the entire Mt. Lee area. In the process, we established and still maintain ongoing relationships with State, Federal Government and local officials.
- Our board members and a strong team of volunteers partnered with local groups to successfully get the City Council approved but fatally flawed Hollywood Community Plan sent back for a new environmental impact study with a downzoning alternative.
- We are actively involved with the ongoing fundraising and litigation against the Millennium Hollywood Project that is planned for atop an active earthquake fault and would add approximately 20,000 car trips per day to our crumbling infrastructure. This added density would make streets in and out of our canyon dangerously gridlocked and add response time to our emergency response systems.
- BCNA has a request in place for handicapped curb cuts for Beachwood Drive and it's approved for year 2014.
- We donate to local causes such as Cheremoya School and Hollywood Orchard as well as supporting the local Police Activities League and other local efforts.

- We maintain a website addressing local interests and providing resources for civic participation (BeachwoodCanyon.org).
- Actively participate with other local organizations to address the unique impacts of tourist and hiker traffic in Beachwood Canyon and the surrounding neighborhoods.
- Monitor development in the Hollywoodland portion of this great Beachwood Canyon by reviewing new projects and attending Hollywoodland Specific Plan Design Review Board meetings.
- Send out newsletters to keep the Canyon informed, enlightened and edified.
- BCNA assists in organizing Emergency Response Training opportunities.
- We maintain our membership in the Federation of Hillside and Canyon Associations to join the effort to keep our hillside neighborhoods safe, healthy and a great place to raise families, play, work and visit.
- We partner with the neighbors and City hosting the annual Trombone Holiday Extravaganza, a free community party that grows every year.
